

2017 cruise season begins at Portsmouth International Port

The cruise season starts at Portsmouth International Port on 22 April, with MV Deutschland taking the honours as the first caller of 2017.

The ship, which was built in 1998, is currently chartered by the leading German cruise operator Phoenix Reisen. With room for more than 500 passengers the traditional liner MV Deutschland has 36 single cabins for solo travellers, a comparatively high number for a vessel of its size.

Whatever length or shape of cruise ship that comes calling at Portsmouth International Port in 2017, each will receive a bespoke flexible service.
