

Crystal Symphony becomes Dover's sixth inaugural call of 2024

Crystal Symphony, which was refurbished last year, sailed into Dover on 30th July for her debut call at the Port and Crystal's first visit of 2024.

Her first turnaround call in the Garden of England began with a 38-night Baltic and Northern Europe cruise to Sweden.
